REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)
Internet Service to ANPM Office

I. Background

Autoridade Nacional do Petróleo e Minerais (ANPM) is Timor-Leste public institution, created under [Decree Law No. 27/2019](#) of 27th August, 2nd amendment of [Decree-Law No. 20/2008](#) of 19th June, on the Autoridade Nacional do Petróleo, responsible of managing and regulating petroleum and mining activities in Timor-Leste area, both offshore and onshore and in the Greater Sunrise Special Regime in accordance with the Decree Law on the establishment of the ANPM, the Timor-Leste Petroleum Activities Law, Maritime Boundary Treaty and the Mining Code.

The ANPM is to establish and supervise compliance with the enacted rules and regulations covering the exploration, development, production, transportation, and distribution of petroleum, natural gas resources, and mineral. It is also tasked to develop a strong petroleum and mineral management institution in Timor-Leste.

Information and Technology have important roles to support all aspects of ANPM business processes, it's therefore, through the ANPM IT Department, we would like to improve the existing ANPM IT Infrastructure and Services to enhance the productivity of ANPM staff by requesting a proposal to provide Internet Service to ANPM main office at Edifício do Ministério das Finanças, Pisos 6 e 7, Aitarak Laran, Dili, Timor-Leste. ANPM requires the vendor to provide internet service with the following Scope of Work (SoW);

II. Scope of Work:

a. Service requirements

- Speed requirement: The ISP must have the capabilities of providing symmetrical internet bandwidth of 15 Mbps.
- The vendor must provide a primary contact number and email address for technical support-related inquires and issues.



- The ISP must be able to provide downtime reports.
- Be qualified as an established firm regularly engaged in the type of business necessary to fulfill the contract requirements.
- The vendor shall be able to relocate some amount of the bandwidth to ANPM branch offices when necessary through Fibre Optic cable in Dili and Wireless link in the Municipalities (ANPM would cover any additional fee at reasonable cost)
- The vendor shall provide an additional amount of bandwidth for a maximum of three days if required to support any online event host by the ANPM during the period of the engagement.

b. Technical requirements:

- The ISP must be able to guarantee network availability more than 97% of the time except for outages caused by the customer's equipment, fiber or wire cuts by third parties, or other events that cannot be controlled by the ISP.
- The Internet connection should be dedicated and not shared with other customers.
- Latency shall be no more than 250 ms.
- Traffic management, network monitoring tools, and access to raw log files;
- The connection is required to be over Fiber Optic.
- The ISP should have the backbone of Fiber Optic connection in town;
- A backup link over Fiber Optic is also required to avoid downtime due to unexpected circumstances.

III. Selection Criteria

Interested vendor/company is requested to provide the following information in their proposal and indicate the abilities to perform the services:

1. Work experiences and capacity to perform the scope of works;
2. Personnel Qualification;
3. Proposed methodology;
4. Work Program and Timelines;
5. Statement of any potential conflicts of interest;
6. Timor-Leste and the country of origin Commercial/Business Registration Certificate including company share capital;
7. Operational License from Autoridade Nacional de Comunicacao de Timor-Leste
8. Declaration of any affiliation with a local company;
9. Company organization structure;



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10. Bank Statements within the last 3 months transaction from the date of the proposal submission;
11. Quotation for performing the task in USD lump sum amount (no amount other than the proposed total fixed price shall be paid)

Note:

- *The proposal to be submitted within two sealed envelopes of technical and financial proposals to ANPM shall be written in English and shall be written in sequence/following the numbering in the selection criteria outlined above.*
- *While price is an important factor, it will not be the primary consideration in evaluating responses to this RFP.*
- *Failed to respond above two notes, will disqualify for the further assessment process.*
