



Visual Presentation Guidelines

We invite university student participants to showcase their research, learning journey, or professional insights through a visual presentation (poster) at the upcoming Women in Resources event on the 20th and 21st November 2025. This is an opportunity to share knowledge, spark conversations, and celebrate the diverse contributions of women in the resources sector.

Students will submit their posters to **Autoridade Nacional do Petróleo (ANP)** by 17 of November 2025 and will be notified if their poster has been selected by 18 of November 2025. Posters selected for the event will be printed and displayed, and students will have the opportunity to present and discuss their work during a dedicated poster showcase session. During this time, the posters will be judged under two categories: Academic Poster Prize (judged by ANP/TLAEP Academic Alumni) and the People's Choice Prize (judged by popular vote).

Purpose

Visual presentations may cover:

- Research projects (completed, in progress, or proposed)
- Topics of personal or professional interest
- Innovations or challenges in the resources sector
- Career pathways or leadership experiences

Format and Size

- Poster Size: A1 (594mm x 841mm) portrait orientation preferred
- Medium: Printed poster
- Language: English preferred
- Layout: Clear headings, readable fonts, and visual elements (charts, photos, diagrams) are encouraged

Content Requirements

Each poster should include:

- 1. Title Clear and engaging
- 2. Author(s) Name, role, and affiliation
- 3. Abstract A summary of the contents
- 4. Introduction Brief background or context about the research
- 5. Objectives What you aim/aimed to learn or explore
- 6. Methodology/Approach If applicable
- 7. Findings or Reflections Key insights or outcomes (can be proposed)
- 8. Conclusion Summary and relevance to the resources sector
- 9. Acknowledgements Any collaborators or supporters
- 10. Contact Information Optional, for networking

Selection Criteria

Presentations will be selected based on:

- Clarity and creativity of communication
- Potential to inspire or inform others

Submission Deadline: November 17, 2025

- Notification of Acceptance: November 18,2025
- **Display Setup:** November 20, 2025

Prizes

- 2. People's Choice Prize judged by popular vote
