UAV-Borne Aeromagnetic Survey – Onshore Timor-Leste

Timor Resources Pty Ltd, Operator of Production Sharing Contracts in partnership with TIMOR GAP, invites suitably qualified and experienced companies to submit an **Expression of Interest (EOI)** to undertake a UAV-borne aeromagnetic survey over approximately 200 km² of onshore Timor-Leste.

The survey objective is to acquire high-quality magnetic data suitable for structural and geological interpretation at depths of up to 1,500 metres. This is a mapping-scale geological survey and is not intended for UXO or engineering applications.

Scope of Work

- Survey planning and flight design
- UAV-based total-field magnetic acquisition
- Static base station operation (diurnal correction)
- Full processing and levelling
- Delivery of interpretation-ready datasets and technical report

Indicative design envelope:

- Traverse line spacing: 200–400 m
- Tie-line spacing: 5–10× traverse spacing
- Terrain clearance: 60–120 m (draped)
- Area: ~200 km²

Planning, acquisition, processing and data delivery within 6 months of contract award.

Technical & Compliance Requirements

Respondents must demonstrate:

- Suitable UAV platform for terrain-following operations
- Total-field scalar magnetometer
- Documented calibration and QA/QC procedures
- Experience delivering mapping-grade magnetic datasets

Survey execution shall align with the Near-Surface Geophysics Inter-Society Committee on UAV Geophysics Guidelines (2022), particularly in relation to safety, positioning, survey planning, and QA/QC.



Experience & Operational Readiness

EOI submissions should include:

- Summary of comparable UAV magnetic surveys
- Platform and sensor specifications
- QA/QC framework
- UAV regulatory compliance and pilot qualifications
- Mobilisation capability and indicative timing
- Robust HSE systems
- Ability to operate in remote environments

Experience in structurally complex environments will be viewed favourably.

1. Company overview and relevant experience
2. Proposed passive seismic methodology
3. Recent project examples
4. Indicative acquisition duration and high-level budget range
5. Key risks and assumptions
